Grace Episcopal Church in Sheboygan, WI is pleased to announce the calling of a new rector, The Rev. William L. Bulson.

Fr. Bulson is originally from Kentucky. He has degrees in Russian literature and Slavic linguistics from the University of Kentucky in Lexington and The Ohio State University in Columbus. This included brief study in Moscow with the Pushkin Institute.

Fr. Bulson received his Master of Divinity from Virginia Theological Seminary, and has served parishes in Appalachia, Minnesota, and Japan, mostly in multi-ethnic and multi-lingual congregations. With the Episcopal Diocese of Minnesota Fr. Bulson co-translated the Book of Common Prayer into Hmong. He served as Rector most recently at St. Alban's Anglican-Episcopal Church in Tokyo, Japan.

Fr. Bulson has been an Oblate with the Order of St. Julian of Norwich in White Lake, WI since 2008. His call to ministry as a parish priest has been confirmed after a time of discernment as a novitiate monk with the order.

Fr. Bulson's first Sunday presiding at Grace Episcopal Church is the First Sunday of Advent, November 29, 2020.

Grace Episcopal Church is a parish church of The Episcopal Diocese of Fond du Lac, established in Sheboygan, Wisconsin in 1847 in the Anglo-Catholic tradition of The Episcopal Church.
